Subject: Re-registration application of Fayaz Ahmad Mir S/o Mr. Abdul Rehman Mir R/o Mugalpora, District Kupwara (under 32C of the Pharmacy Act, 1948-regarding)-Rejection thereof.

Whereas, the Pharmacy Council of Union Territory of J&K issued a Public Notice under endorsement no:JKPC-86/Estt/681-91, Dated: 16.12.2020 inviting therein applications for re-registration/validation of Pharmacist Registration certificates of all those persons who were registered as Pharmacist under the repealed J&K Pharmacy Act, Samvat, 2011, (1955, A.D);

Whereas, the above exercise was initiated in pursuance to provisio (32C) incorporated in the Pharmacy Act, 1948 notified vide S.O no: **3465(E), Dated: 05th of October, 2020**;

Whereas, registration as Pharmacist had been granted in favour of **Mr. Fayaz Ahmad Mir S/o Mr. Abdul Rehman Mir R/o Mugalpora, District Kupwara** bearing registration number 9343, Dated: 23.06.2007 under the repealed J&K Pharmacy Act, Samvat, 2011.

Whereas, on the basis of application no: PHAR012623 through Online portal, the applicant applied for re-registration as Pharmacist under Section 32C of the Pharmacy Act, 1948;

Whereas, on the basis of recommendations furnished by the concerned Junior Assistant of the J&K Pharmacy Council, the re-registration was granted;

Whereas an exercise was undertaken by the Office of the J&K Pharmacy Council to secure due diligence that the re-registrations accorded are in consonance with records available with the repealed Council;

Whereas, it was found that **Mr. Fayaz Ahmad Mir S/o Mr. Abdul Rehman Mir R/o Mugalpora, District Kupwara** had resorted to misrepresentation, concealment of facts and thereby used unfair approach to seek re-registration


under Section 32C of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 since the said registration under the repealed Act had been cancelled vide this office order no: PC/08/3282-87, Dated: 07.02.2008 & PC/08/3393-96, Dated: 18.02.08 following a complaint lodged by people of Kupwara (copies enclosed);

Whereas, the matter was discussed by the Council and it has been decided that the re-registration so granted vide no: JKPC/32C/12623, Dated: 06.01.2022 requires to be cancelled abinitio on the basis of contents of para supras;

Now, therefore the undersigned in exercise of powers vested under Section (41) of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 rejects the application of the applicant for re-registration as Pharmacist in terms of Section 32(C) of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 & imposes a penalty of Rs. 500/- (First conviction) to be deposited in the bank account of J&K Pharmacy Council bearing bank details:
