Subject →	Cancellation/Rejection of registration as Pharmacist of application of Mr. Roaf Ahmad Wani S/o Mr. Mohd Yousuf Wani, R/o Nowgam Shangus Achabal, District-Anantnag (under 32 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948-regarding).

**Whereas**, the Pharmacy Council of Union Territory of J&K issued a Public Notice under endorsement no: JKPC-86/Estt/681-91, Dated: 16.12.2020 inviting therein applications for registration as Pharmacist under the Pharmacy Act, 1948;

**Whereas**, the above exercise was initiated in pursuance to the implementation of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 in the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir after the enforcement of J&K Reorganization Act, 2019;

**Whereas**, an application for registration as Pharmacist under Section 32 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 from your end was uploaded in the Online portal vide Form reference number **PHAR011610, Dated: 30.08.2023** along with requisite documents as prescribed under the Checklist;

**Whereas**, a matter of practice and procedure, the eligibility certificate uploaded from the applicants end was referred to the concerned university/examining body for purpose of verifying as genuineness;

**Whereas**, the Competent Authority, i.e. **Registrar, CMJ University, Meghalaya** communication no: **CMJ/RO/VERI/2026-02, Dated: 17.02.2026 mail dated: 18.02.2026** vehemently disowned the issuance of **Diploma in Pharmacy** certificate from their side and therefore suggesting that the same has been treated as **fake** with the following remarks:

**“With reference to your letter cited above, we would like to inform you that the copy of the Diploma in Pharmacy Certificate bearing registration no. 97098419700034 of the candidate named Mr. Roaf Ahmad Wani, send by you is not issued by Chanakya Institute of Pharmaceutical Science & Research, CMJ University, Meghalaya. Hence it is Fake.”**

**Whereas**, the response highlighted herein above clearly indicates that the claims of eligibility by the applicant are not bonafide & further the said person has indulged in unfair means;

Whereas, at the time of filing the application through online portal, the applicant has also submitted an affidavit duly sworn before Ist Class Judicial Magistrate, Anantnag with one of the below averments:

“That in the event, my eligibility for registration as Pharmacist is found to have been acquired through misrepresentation, impersonation or concealment of material facts and found false, the Pharmacy Council shall have a right to strike off my registration as Pharmacist ab-initio without providing me any opportunity for being heard”.

Whereas, the above person was offered an opportunity to provide his response in the matter through show cause notice vide this office letter bearing no: JKPC/SCN/2026/PHARR011610/Estt-2411-2418, Dated: 03.03.2026;

Whereas, no reply was received from the applicants end;

Whereas, the applicant has failed to respond to the communications reflected in para supras and therefore the applicant has not availed of his right to be heard before a decision in the matter is taken.

Now, therefore the undersigned in exercise of powers vested under the Pharmacy Act, 1948 rejects the application of the applicant for registration as Pharmacist with immediate effect.

(The above action is being taken in pursuance to the communication forwarded by the CMJ University, Meghalaya reflected at para supra (Inter-alia disputing your eligibility claims for registration as Pharmacist).
