Whereas, the Pharmacy Council of Union Territory of J&K issued a Public Notice under endorsement no: JKPC-86/Estt/681-91, Dated: 16.12.2020 inviting therein applications for registration as Pharmacist under the Pharmacy Act, 1948;

Whereas, the above exercise was initiated in pursuance to the implementation of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 in the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir following enforcement of J&K Reorganization Act, 2019;



Whereas, the Assistant Registrar, (Examination), Bundelkhand University, Jhansi, U.P vide their communication no: BU/Conf/2024/17236, Dated: 09.12.24 has vehemently disowned the issuance of communication no: U.P BU/2814/REQ/CONF, Dated: 20.08.2024 from their side in respect of following 05 applicants with below remarks:

Whereas, on the basis of information obtained during investigation, it is now clear beyond any shadow of doubt that the above mentioned applicants have indulged in manipulation & misrepresentation in order to gain a lateral entry into the register of Pharmacists maintained by the J&K Pharmacy Council in the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir;

Now therefore, in light of contents of foregoing paras, the applications of all such applicants whose credentials have been disputed by the concerned competent authority (Assistant Registrar, (Examination), Bundelkhand University, Jhansi) and applied through the online portal of J&K Pharmacy Council are hereby rejected ab-initio.
