Whereas, the Pharmacy Council of Union Territory of J&K issued a Public Notice under endorsement no:JKPC-86/Estt/681-91, Dated: 16.12.2020 inviting therein applications for re-registration/validation of Pharmacist Registration certificates of all those persons who were registered as Pharmacist under the repealed J&K Pharmacy Act, Samvat, 2011, (1955, A.D);

Whereas, the above exercise was initiated in pursuance to provisio (32C) incorporated in the Pharmacy Act, 1948;

Whereas, an application from your end was uploaded in the Online Portal vide Form reference no: PHAR002660, Dated: 23.12.2020;

Whereas, after perusal of office records/scrutiny of uploaded documents following discrepancies were observed;


- i. That the registration number: "**130/02/K**" mentioned in the uploaded certificate actually belongs to "**Mrs. Sunita Sharma D/o Krishan Kumar R/o Nagri Parole, Distt-Kathua**";

Whereas, you have indulged in unfair means and submitted fictitious documents by resorting to manipulation and misrepresentation/impersonation;

Whereas, there is every apprehension that the certificate so uploaded could have been misused by you to obtain subsequent regulatory clearance;

In light of the contents of foregoing paras and before initiating any action in the matter, you are hereby afforded an opportunity to furnish your response and comments to the undersigned through return mail by or before 15.02.2023 positively;

It may be noted that in the event of your failure to respond to this notice, the Council shall be constrained to initiate ex-parte action against you.
