Public Notice.

Reference: Letter no: 28-33/2020/PCI/3000-3001, Dated: 17.09.2020 & PCI Public Notice no: 28-I/2017-PCI/7310, Dated: 20.12.2019.

All candidates who are pursuing Diploma in Pharmacy Course from institutions duly recognized by the competent authority are supposed to undergo practical training in terms of **Section 4.4 of Pharmacy Practice Regulations, 2015 (PPR-15)**, which is reproduced as under:

"Practical training to student Pharmacists.

- a) The owner of the Pharmacy shall seek prior approval of the PCI for approval of the Pharmacy for the purpose of imparting practical teaching to student of Diploma in Pharmacy. In the absence of approval from the PCI, the student Pharmacists shall not be treated to have completed their Diploma in Pharmacy (Part-III) to make them eligible for Registration as a Pharmacist under the Act.
- b) The Registered pharmacist shall impart practical training to student pharmacists as prescribed from time to time under Education Regulations framed u/s 10 of the Act under intimation to the examining authority.
- c) While imparting such practical training, the registered pharmacist shall comply with the prescribed norms relating to number of students pharmacists to be trained, nature of

practical training, duration of practical etc as laid down under the Education Regulations from time to time”.

It may be noted that candidates who apply for registration as Pharmacist before the Pharmacy Council of Union Territory of J&K (Online mode-Portal) without undergoing Practical Training shall not be considered for registration as Pharmacist by the Pharmacy Council of Union Territory of J&K.

However, the above condition shall not apply to such candidates who have already completed the Diploma Course in Pharmacy from approved institutions before the issuance of under reference Public Notice issued by Pharmacy Council of India.
